EVALUATING DRIVER RECORDS

Your organization should evaluate every driver's performance annually or as often as needed. You can use the matrix below for this purpose. When a Motor Vehicle Report is ordered and the results examined, you will be able to see if the driver has had any moving violations, in addition to reviewing your records to determine if they have had any at fault accidents.

Moderate Risk: Require closer monitoring of driving behavior, including driver testing.

High Risk: Recommend disciplinary action for existing drivers, or no hire for a

prospective driver.

Severe Risk: Recommend that such a driver not operate any vehicle on behalf of the

organization.

Note: Any one DUI case is considered in the "Severe Risk" category.
