

Recommended Age Levels for Evaluating Drivers

The Risk Pooling Trust recommends that drivers be evaluated at age 70, 74, 77, 79 and each year thereafter to determine if they have the skills to safely operate a motor vehicle. In addition to those ages, the Trust recommends that each driver that has been evaluated and placed with restrictions should be evaluated each year along with any drivers that are considered to be dangerous for any reason.
